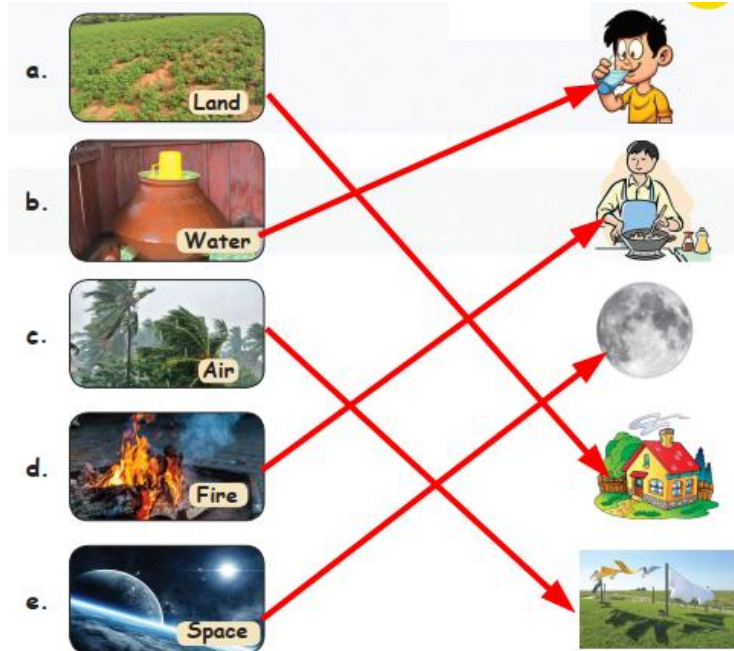

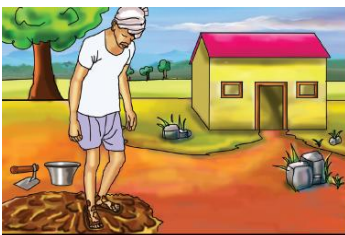

There is a heap of Clay



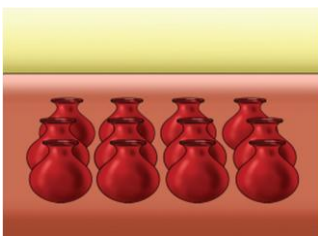
His helper pours water over it.



The potter mixes both the water and clay



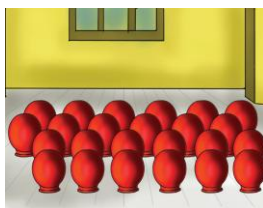
He makes pots using a Wheel.
